This Deed of Declaration of Trust is made Today The 28<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF MAY 2016 by SACHINDRA RAY, VILL.- KHARAHYA, PO- MANGALGARH, PS AND BLOCK- HASANPUR, Dist:- SAMASTIPUR, PIN - 848208

Whereas The Settlor is a social worker.

AND WHEREAS the Main thrust of the Settlor's thinking and practical effort has been towards educational development, mutual understanding and cohesion between different communities in a value based society, training and economic development of poor, neglected and down trodden Indians in general, pollution free environment and working towards goal of health for all.

AND WHEREAS after discussing the matter with people, the settlor has nominated and requested whose names and addresses have been mentioned herein below to act as trustees :

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4. That the object for which the Trust is created are:
- a. To establish and administer different professional Institute , Technical Institute , BED Training College, Nursing Training College, Medical College, Engineering College, MBA College, Para Medical College, Dental College, non-technical Institutes , Schools, Colleges (Intermediate and Degree) and other institutions of similar nature.
  - b. To establish and administer model education, Academic , Technical, Vocational and Professional Institution in the Country of India.
  - c. To establish research Institutions and provide scientific research in the fields of Bio Technology especially Plant Bio technology for quality product and increased food productions & food processing and Information Technology including Bio Informatics.
  - d. To Impart Vocational , entrepreneurship and technical training including Computer Literacy Programme for the eradication of Unemployment and to organize professional courses as per the requirement of time.
  - e. To establish Libraries, Museums, Workshops & such other establishments.
  - f. To disburse grants & aids for promoting the educational & cultural interests of all the community.
  - g. To establish and maintain libraries reading rooms, community halls etc. for the use and convenience of students and general public.
  - h. To make arrangement for the financial assistance in the form of scholarship or otherwise to the unprivileged classes of the Society.

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- i. To establish coaching and guidance centers for the students of Deprived and Socially backward community and other Backward classes including SC AND ST to ensure their employment and admission to institute of professional courses.
- j. National community and International peace and amity, Communal and social harmony and brotherhood.
- k. Promotion and extension of appropriate technology including systems having renewable sources of energy.
- l. To take up programmes for ensuring protection of Environment and also for regeneration of natural resources degraded due to our past neglects.
- p. To start, maintain and assist any relief measures in those parts which are or become subjected to natural calamities such as Floods, Fire, Drought, Famine, Cyclone, earthquake, Storm accident etc.
- q. Promotion of cottage and small scale industries by taking up action research work.
- r. Promotion and progress of agriculture and animal husbandry.
- s. To undertake evaluation of economic and social projects.
- t. To take up programmes in which Science and Technology may have major role in improving life, working conditions and opportunities for gainful employment of women and socially weaker section, and to work for economic development of the poor sections of the Society for eradication of poverty, illiteracy, injustice, deprivation and backwardness.

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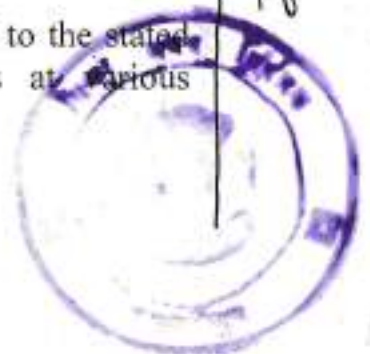


to take up enforcement of prohibition and initiate people's movement against smoking, alcoholism and drug abuse.

- u. To take up programmes for accelerating pace of rural development by application of science and technology ( techniques and technologies for cost reduction, improving productivity etc.) specially in the field of water exploration , watershed and purification , sanitation, low cost housing, agriculture and animal husbandry and engineering sources.
- v. Propagation and promotion of work centers and cooperation of any kind or others and giving organizations etc. in the furtherance of the objects of organization.
- w. To undertake programmes which ensures raising of income levels and expending employment opportunities of the weaker sections of society specially of those leaving below poverty lines and women by involving participants in the planning, implementation and maintenance of activities taken up. To give, provide training for better and modern/up to date Technical farming, Fisheries, Poultry form, Animal husbandry, Horticulture, Training of Handicrafts, Fine arts and other useful arts, crafts including the establishment and maintenance of Shilpa- Shikhalayas, Kala-Kendra and other small industries by virtue of which people fight against poverty by Self- employment.
- X) To take up all formal and non formal education programme. To undertake basic research and survey in the areas of health, education and family welfare, environment etc.
- Y) To undertake implement able activities related to the stated areas by creating network of sub- offices at various geographical locations, if required.

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- Z) To undertake training and educational campaigns as part of strategic implementation plan.
- ZA) To undertake activities that are oriented towards the promotion of family welfare, including the delivery of family welfare services.
- ZB) To encourage people specially women and those belonging to weaker sections to develop the livelihood, income and employment generating opportunities and activities by taking up various income generation schemes like fisheries, dairy, agriculture, floriculture, horticulture, cottage and small industries, vending in the form of SHG's.
- ZC) To set up educational facilities for girls, minorities, SC, ST, OBC's and other weaker sections of the society and to work for the Protection and Preservation of Birds and Animals
- ZD) To set up old age home, orphanage, reform homes for socially neglected children and women etc.
- ZE) To raise or acquire funds or property from central government, state government, foreign agencies, non-government agencies, charitable trusts by way of donations or grants or contributions or by taking loan from public and private financial institutions. The funds, properties, assets and all other resources, present and future, of the society shall be utilised for any or all the purpose or objects of the society as state above and also for similar activities in furtherance of ideals of truth and non violence.
- ZF) To promote and advertise various systems of medicines.
- ZG) To organise various kinds of professional and vocational education programmes for unemployed persons and women and to work for the encouragement of Sports Activities in rural and other areas.

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## 6. Management

That the Trust shall be managed by the Board of Trustees. That the maximum number of Trustees shall be 11 and not less than Seven at any time. That the Trustees will hold their meetings at least four times in a year but not more than at an interval of four months in each meetings. That the presence of one third of the Trustees personally present will be the quorum for the meeting. That any Trustee may resign from the Trusteeship and the Trustees in that meeting are empowered to accept the same. That the Trustees are empowered to fill up the vacancy in the Board of Trustees. That a person of the age of 21 years or beyond having interest in the Educational activities can be taken as a Trustees by the remaining Trustees. That the Trustees who are to found to work derogatory to the interest of the Trust may be removed by two-thirds majority of the Trustees in their meeting but before that the Trustees are required to give notice to such Trustee for the lapses on his particulars. That any Trustee who is leaving India for good or who remains absent continuously in three meeting without permission can be removed from the Trusteeship of the Trust.

That the Trustees are empowered to reimburse for the expenses incurred for the Trust and its activities out of their own funds.

## 7. Accounts

That the Trustees shall maintain true and fair accounts of all receipts and payments of the Trust and accounts so maintained shall remain at the registered office of the trust.

That the accounting year of the Trust will be from April to March every year and the first accounts of the Trust shall close on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2017. That the Trustees are empowered to appoint a Chartered Accountant for audit of the accounts of the Trust and to fix their remuneration of such auditors.

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That the accounts so prepared and audited shall be placed before the Special

Meeting of the Trustees within three months of the closure of the accounts Along with the report of the Auditors. That the accounts so audited shall be printed and published and may be sent to donors of the Trust and the Trustees.

#### 8. *Trust meetings*

That the Trustees shall meet every quarter for the purpose of the Trust and for the management of the Trust and its funds. That the decisions are to be taken by majority. That personal presence of one third of Trustees will be the quorum for a meeting. Convened by a short notice of 12 hours.

#### 9. *Special meetings*

That the Trust will have in a year its special meetings before 30<sup>th</sup> June of every year in which the audited accounts of the Trust are to be placed before the special Meeting of the Trustees to approve and adopt such accounts and the report, but for the ensuing year shall also be led before the meeting.

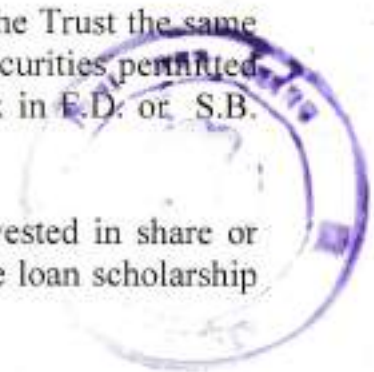
#### 10. *Investments*

That the funds collected for the Trust shall be utilised for carrying out the Trust or acquiring the capital assets or constructing the building, etc., for the purpose of the Trust.

That in case any surplus remain with the Trust the same will be invested in the Government Securities permitted for the Trust or to remain in the Bank in F.D. or S.B. Accounts.

That no part of the funds shall be invested in share or advance for loan to other excepting the loan scholarship

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granted by the Trustees while framing rules for the same.

#### 11. *Nature of trust*

That the nature of the Trust is Public Charitable Trust and the benefit of the Trust shall be available to the beneficiaries without any distinction of cast, creed, religion or sex.

#### 12. *Amendment in trust deed*

That the Trust Deed can be amended by two-thirds majority of the Trustees in a meeting specially called for the purpose by giving 14 days notice for the purpose and the resolution passed by such majority as circulated with or without notification shall be final and binding for good for his Deed.

#### 13. *Powers of the Trustees*

That overall control of the Trust shall be in the Trustees who will exercise their powers and control through the Executive Committee of the Trustees appointed by them for the purpose or through the office bearers elected by themselves out of them.

That the Executive Committee or Office bearers shall have the following powers in general:

To raise, collect or arrange for the donations for the benefit of the Trust and to invest such funds from time to time.

To decide about the educational activities to be undertaken by the Trust.





To make rules for running of the Institutions or giving donations or appointment of the officers and teachers as well as for the meeting held by them.

The Trustees are empowered to appoint and terminate the employees of the employees of the Trust.

The Trustees are further empowered to open and operate Bank Account or accounts with any scheduled Bank and may exercise/authorize either of them to operate the same jointly with any two of the President, Treasurer and Secretary .

The Trustees are also empowered to donate the funds to a Trust having similar objects.

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#### 14. *Office bearers*

01. For the smooth running of the Trust the Trustees are empowered to elect the following office bearers out of themselves :

- (i) Chairman
- (ii) Secretary
- (iii) Treasurer

Four Executive members shall be elected by the general body.

That the office-bearers so elected by them shall hold office for a period of Five years and In every Five years in the month of June there will be fresh elections but the retiring office bearers may be re-elected in the meeting called for the election of the office bearers.

#### 15. *Chairman*

That the Chairman of the Trust will be the virtual Head of the Trustees and will preside over all the meeting of the Trust. The Chairman shall be elected by the general body and will be the chairman of Board of trustees as well as chairman of



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the executive committee. In the event of vacancy of the chairman caused by the death, resignation or otherwise, the Vice Chairman shall function as chairman. The Vice Chairman shall hold office for the remaining period of five years for which out going Chairman was selected.

#### 16. *Secretary*

The Board of Trustees are empowered to elect a Secretary out of themselves to manage the affairs of the Trust and to look after its day-to-day business. All records of this trust shall remain in the custody of the secretary. The Secretary is entitled to call for the meeting of the Trust under the permission of the Chairman.

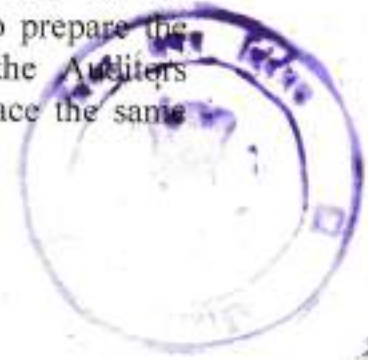
The Secretary shall be empowered to represent Trust in all cases in court of authorities.

The Secretary shall prepare the Annual Report of the Trust and place the same before the Board of Trustees.

#### 17. *Treasurer*

That out of Trustees, the Trustees are empowered to elect one Treasurer for holding the office for a period of five years. The Treasurer shall be responsible for keeping all records and maintain the account of all receipt and payments. He will be required to prepare the annual budget of the Trust and will place it before the special meeting of the Trust for the approval. The Treasurer will also be required to prepare the final accounts to get the same audited by the Auditors appointed by the Board of Trustees and will place the same before the special meeting of the Trustees.

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committee set up by the Trust and in respect of any matter within the jurisdiction of the trust.

- c) The Executive Committee shall be competent of affiliate other organisation/Institution on such terms and conditions as approved by the Board of Trustees.
- d) The quorum of any meeting of the Board of Trustees, Executive Committee or any committee or sub-committee shall be one-third of member. If the quorum is not complete, the meeting shall be adjourned and reconvened by the Chairman. There shall be no quorum for the adjourned meeting.
- e) The Executive Committee shall be competent to open branches, offices of institution any where in India.
- f) Any member of the Trust or Executive Committee or any office bearer may resign at any time from the office or membership held by him/her by writing to the Chairman. The Chairman may address his resignation to the Executive Committee through the secretary of the Trust. The resignation of tendered shall become effective from the date it is accepted by the Executive Committee.
- g) The Executive Committee shall open or caused to be open Bank Account/accounts in the name of the Trust in a schedule in the name of the Trust in a scheduled Bank/Banks. All such accounts shall be operated by the signatures of any two of the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.
- h) The financial year of the Trust for the purpose of maintaining and closing accounts and for the purpose of budget shall commence from the month of April and end with the month of March every calendar year.
- i) All deeds and other documents to be executed by or on behalf of the Trust shall be done, by the Chairman and



the Trust may be sued in the name of the Chairman of the Trust. All pleadings including plaints, written statements, counter affidavit, applications, petitions, affidavits etc. in all the proceedings by or against the Trust shall be signed and verified by the Chairman.
